Sailboat Mast Storage and Removal



Store boat with mast up.

This is the most cost-effective option, available to outside storage customers only. Removal of the mast head instruments is recommended to ensure that they remain protected from the harsh winter conditions.

Mast Storage Options Deck Storage

This option is only available for boats up to 35 feet, with a requirement that the mast does not extend more than 2 feet over each end of the boat. Support horses are provided where needed and mast is secured to boat. Removal of the mast head instruments is recommended if stored outside.

Indoor Storage

Store your boat's mast in our dedicated mast storage building for maximum protection. This storage option is required if you are having your mast serviced during the off-season.
